***‘Fixing Frederick Felines’ Program
Participation Agreement***

The Animal Welfare League of Frederick County established ‘Fixing Frederick Felines’ to help citizens and property owners manage the population and improve the health and welfare of free-roaming cats through a Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) service.

As a Participant of the Program, I understand and agree to the following conditions:

1. On a long-term basis, I will provide adequate food, water and shelter for the cat(s) trapped, neutered and returned.
2. On a long-term basis, I will monitor the health of the cat(s). If it appears that a cat needs medical attention, I will notify the Animal Welfare League and request assistance with trapping the cat and making arrangements for medical care with a veterinarian who agrees to handle free-roaming cats.
3. The cat(s) will be spayed/neutered and given rabies and distemper vaccinations. The cat(s) will be ear-tipped (tip of left ear removed) for easy identification of being spayed/neutered. From time to time, the Animal Welfare League may recommend the administration of other medical treatment.
4. The Animal Welfare League will work with me to find the best possible solution (depending on age and temperament) for any litters of kittens involved in the trapping process.
5. The Animal Welfare League has made arrangements with participating veterinarians to obtain the most reasonable rates possible for required care. The Animal Welfare League will pay the veterinarian bills and I will make a tax-deductible donation to the Animal Welfare League for the agreed upon medical fee(s). In the amount of \$ _____ .

As with any veterinary treatment and/or surgery, there are associated risks. As a Participant, I agree that I will not hold the Animal Welfare League liable for any outcome which results in the loss of an animal.

6. I understand that the traps to be used are the property of Animal Welfare League and are to be used only to trap, neuter, and release the animals on my site.

7. I understand that Animal Welfare League is a no-kill rescue group, and that the traps are not to be used to take cats to the shelter or a veterinarian to be euthanized. No traps are to be given to any other person for any reason. If I know of persons needing help I will refer them to the Animal Welfare League.

8. I will return the traps to Animal Welfare League as soon as the cats have recovered from surgery, and have been release. Twenty-four hours minimum for male cars, and 48 hours minimum for females. Exceptions can be made if an animal required medications and must remain in the trap for a period of time. This will be worked out with the person assisting you.

9. For AWLFC to be able to help the largest number of cats and property owners, I agree to endeavor to trap these cats within the next 2 weeks. During that time I will maintain contact with the AWLFC representative and will request additional time for use of the traps, as required.
